## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Students on F-1 Visa must submit a one-time non-refundable application fee of \$300. Students are required to pay tuition for both Sessions One and Two at the time of enrollment.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

Payments can be made by Cash, Check, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover card according to the payment options listed below.

- **Option one:** Single payment of full tuition before registration for the session.
- **Option two:** One-half of the tuition to be paid before registration, the other half due four weeks after classes begin with an additional charge of \$10.

**Refunds:** If a refund is applicable, the amount will be processed within 30 days of the receipt of a written request

## NOTE

Service fee of 3.5% will be charged for payments made by credit cards and \$20 for payments by check.

## STUDENT WITHDRAWAL

If a student wishes to withdraw, completely or partially, the student must sign and submit, personally or by mail, the prescribed forms to the Record's Office by the published deadline. Verbal withdrawals are not accepted.

## FINANCIAL AID

A variety of financial aid is available to qualified students attending EWU. Students who are eligible to participate in the various financial aid programs available from the U.S.

Department of Education and other government agencies are responsible for the timely submission of all forms, applications and documentation required by those agencies. If a student fails to submit the necessary materials by the proper deadlines and therefore is deemed ineligible for financial aid, the student then becomes solely responsible for making payments due to the University.

NOTE: The amounts shown are the maximum amounts that you may borrow for an academic year (annual loan limits) and in total (aggregate loan limits). You might receive less than the maximum if you receive other financial aid that's used to cover a portion of your cost of attendance. The maximum amount that you may borrow can also be less in certain situations.

PLUS is a federal loan program for dependent undergraduate students. Generally, parents are eligible if they do not have an adverse credit history and are not in default on a federal student loan.

Housing cost may be included in the financial aid package to qualifying students otherwise the amount of loans is limited to tuition and fees only.

### SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED BY EAST-WEST UNIVERSITY

Only full-time students (taking a minimum of 24 credit hours per session) are eligible for one of the following scholarships except the Merit Scholarship which can be combined with one additional scholarship.
